### Associate Membership

Membership of the Company is open to everyone involved, connected or interested in water and the environment. The Company is particularly committed to encouraging and supporting students and younger people in their early careers through membership of the company.

#### Eligibility

Associate Membership is open to everyone, particularly anyone who has relatively recently become involved, connected or interested in water and the environment. Associate Members can only remain as such for a maximum of 5 years irrespective of their age with the strong expectation and the support so that they become full members within that time.

#### Benefits

- Access to Company webinars as well as specific Associate Member activities such as talks with industry leaders and experts, social gatherings, and technical visits.
- Opportunity to receive mentoring by senior Company members to help broaden skills and knowledge and to support professional development.
- Connecting with other Associate Members and networking with individual and corporate members of the Company, the City of London and the wider Livery.
- Attendance at formal Company Lunches and dinners by personal invitation from members.
- Possibility to progress to become a full Freeman or Liveryman of the Company.
- Support to become a Freeman of the City of London at the Company's discretion.
- Possibility of claiming Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Credits for their participation in relevant Company activities.

#### Fee

There is an initial joining fee of £50 which covers the first year until 1 July, and thereafter a fee of £50 per year for a further 4 years. Within this time Associate Members are encouraged to consider becoming Freemen of the Company.
