Following on from the continuing success of our City Water Debates, with the last one held in November 2023, we are very pleased to announce preliminary details of our next City Water Debate.

This will take place at Bakers' Hall, Harp Lane, London EC3R 6DP on Thursday 21 March 2024 from 5.30pm.

Major investment will be needed in water infrastructure over the next 25 years. Traditional physical engineering solutions involve treatment plants and pipelines, many of which come with a high carbon footprint. This debate will consider the scope for a nature-based system approach, involving joint working between a range of parties, and the challenges, including financing and delivering such solutions
