The Lord Mayor of London is one of the world's oldest elected officials, and every November, when the new Mayor takes office they travel upriver to Westminster to pledge loyalty to the Crown.

The Lord Mayor travels 1.7 miles from Mansion House to the Royal Courts, Aldwych, and the following Lord Mayor's procession is 3 miles long. It will take over an hour to pass, and when the first floats reach Aldwych most of the procession is still waiting to set off.

At the 2011 Lord Mayors Show on 10 November, was attended by The Worshipful Company of Water Conservators. Unfortunately their audition for the West End revival of A Chorus Line was unsuccessful!
