The Lord Mayor cut the ribbon at 8am and, with the band playing rousing music, they were off! Roger and Christine commented "it was a most moving and enjoyable spectacle which was well worth the early start!"

This amazing convoy can be over three miles long when running and consists of 100 plus taxis, City of London Police escorts, Gendarmerie Nationale, London Ambulance NHS Trust vehicles and AA breakdown trucks.
