Matthew won the award for his report *Conceptual and Numerical Modelling of Superficial Groundwater Flow to Improve Local Abstraction Impact Predictions* which he submitted in fulfilment of his MSc degree at Birmingham University. Matthew now works as a hydrogeologist for Affinity Water, undertaking groundwater resources investigations.
